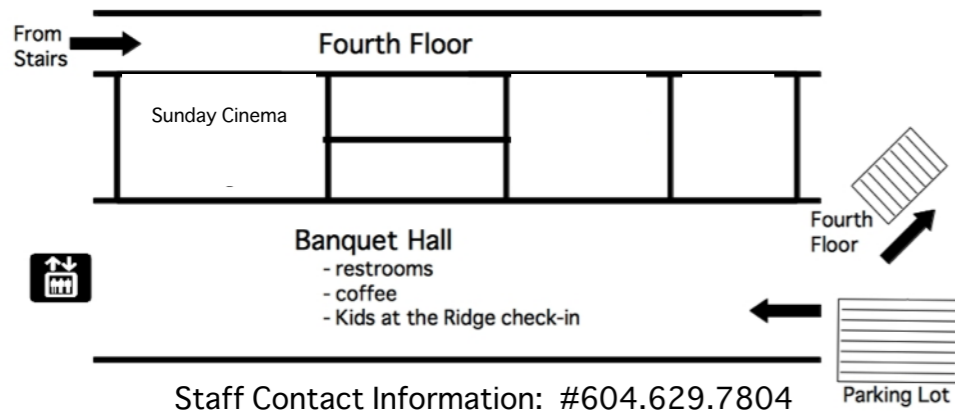
House of Hope Service Day - July 23

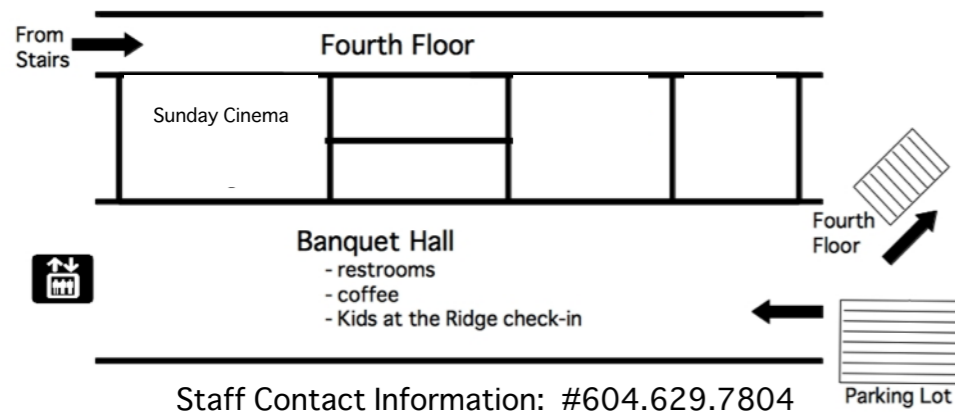
